In the Episcopal polity, each parish is selfsupporting.

Our budget is heavily reliant on our pledging. The Vestry - charged with managing the financial resources has to make decisions about what we can and cannot afford to do. Prayerfully consider making the most generous pledge you can afford.

Did you know?

Every dime the diocese spends comes from us, the pledging parishioners (okay, they rely on some grants too). Our annual diocesan assessment is about 15% of every dollar we spend in our operating budget. In 2008 the diocesan assessment was **\$8,000**.

Last year it was **\$23,160!**

St. Paul's Finances

In 2019 our budget is roughly \$240,000.

For the 2019 year we had ~50 pledges totaling about \$125,000. The rest comes from various gifts, grants, rental and investment income, and a planned 4% draw on our endowment.

Last year annual pledges ranged from \$50 to \$10,000. Everyone can contribute something!

Where does it all go?

Our pledging dollars make every part of our ministry happen! The annual budget funds our **building** and **grounds**, **utilities**, **office** and **administration**, our **rector**, our **music program** and all of the **beloved ministries** supported by our community.

Financial support is just one component of stewardship.

Consider contributing to any one of a number of ministries that make the Parish of St. Paul the vibrant, beloved community of faith that we have always been. Some examples (see the "Annual Giving" page that follows in this packet for the complete list):

How do I begin to think about my pledge? Pledging is a spiritual practice.

The first step is to think about your gratitude for this community and all that you are able to contribute in and through it. What does this beloved community add to God's world?

And think not just about St. Paul's serves you directly, but also how St. Paul's serves other parishioners, our neighbors and the wider world.

We rely on pledges and not dues for a reason: we don't welcome only those who can afford to be here; rather we are a community who knows that if each among us gives as generously as we can, all are welcomed unconditionally. How can I pay my pledge?
